Water Quality Results

Hedgecourt Lake is tested approximately every two weeks by a fully accredited water quality testing laboratory. In line with Environment Agency guidelines CMYC aims to test water quality about 20 times a year. Under the Bathing Water Regulations 2013 there are four categories of water quality for swimming:

EXCELLENT GOOD SUFFICIENT POOR

The bacterial standards are:

E.coli: less than 500 colony forming units per 100 ml of water = "EXCELLENT"; less than 1,000 = "GOOD"; .

Intestinal Enterococci (IE): less than 200 colony forming units per 100 ml of water = "EXCELLENT"; less than 400 cfu/100ml = "GOOD".
