# **CMYC Volunteer Recognition Structure (2024)**

Awards may be made for special achievements or significant contributions to club activities as follows.

# **Honorary Membership**

- a. Someone who has previously received a Lifetime Achievement Award and has now retired from an active role.
- b. A significant contribution by someone during the course of their membership who has ceased to be a member.
- c. Someone connected to CMYC that has had significant success or made a significant contribution in the wider world of sailing.

Note: A recipient is not entitled to vote at General Meetings or to be elected to the committee but may use the facilities of the Club.

Who decides: Conferred by Committee on an as required basis.

#### Reward:

• Free membership for Life.

### **Lifetime Achievement Award**

Awarded in recognition of a major contribution to the running of the club over a significant number of years.

Who decides: Nominated and decided by Committee on an as required basis.

#### Reward:

- Free Membership for 5 years.
- Engraved gift to value £75.
- Engraved silver salver held for one year.

## **Exceptional Contribution Award**

Awarded in recognition of an exceptional contribution to the running of the Club over one, or more, years.

Who decides: Nominated and decided by the Committee on an as required basis.

#### Reward:

- Free Membership for 1 year.
- Engraved gift to value £50.

#### **Significant Contribution Award**

Awarded to those that have made a significant contribution over one, or more, years.

**Who decides:** Nominated by Committee; Training and Sailing Sub-Committee's and Estate Manager for Tuesday Group volunteers on an as required basis. Decided by Committee.

## Reward:

- Engraved glass.
- £50 Voucher

## Junior Sub-Committee Special Award – Robin Ballam Trophy

Significant contribution to the support of junior events at home or away

Who decides: Junior Sub-Committee

## Reward:

- Trophy held for a year.
- Engraved glass.
- £50 voucher.

Additional awards may be made at the discretion of the Sub-Committee for lesser but worthy contributions. These have a maximum value of £30 and do not include an engraved glass.
